

This is the **entrance** to the library.

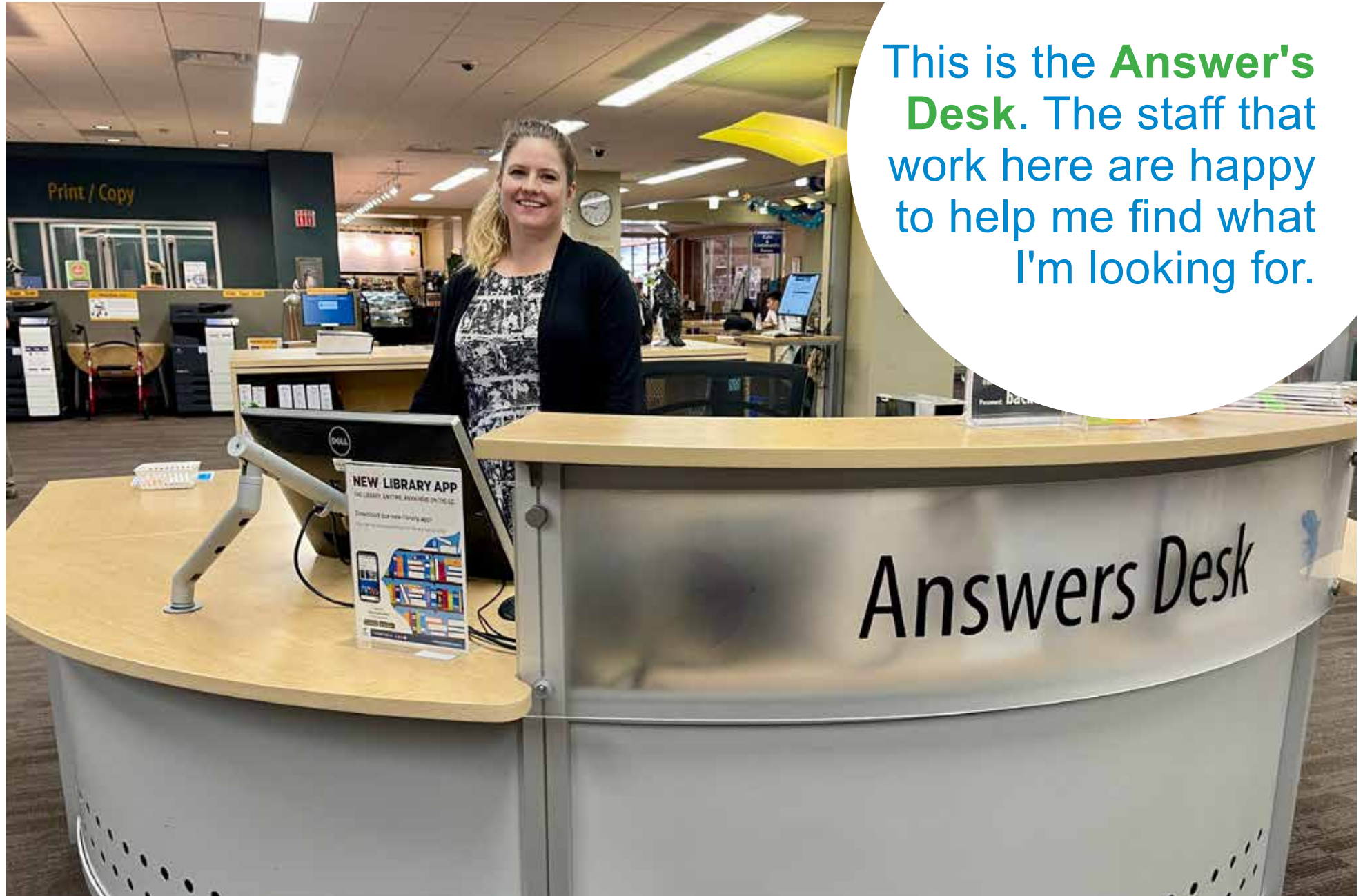
The doors open automatically as I approach.

Hand Dryers - **Loud**

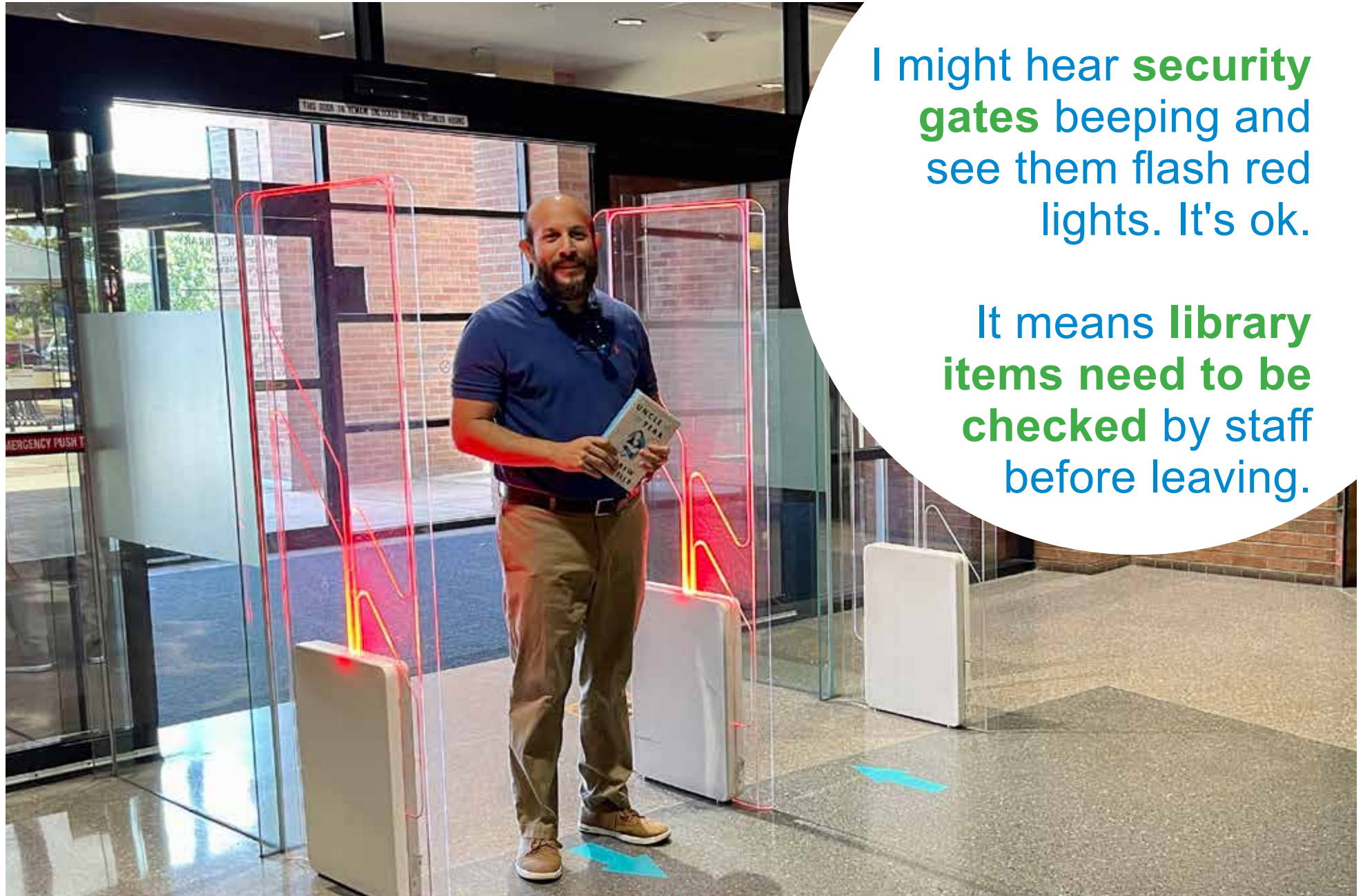


Printers - **Moderate**

Children - **Loud**



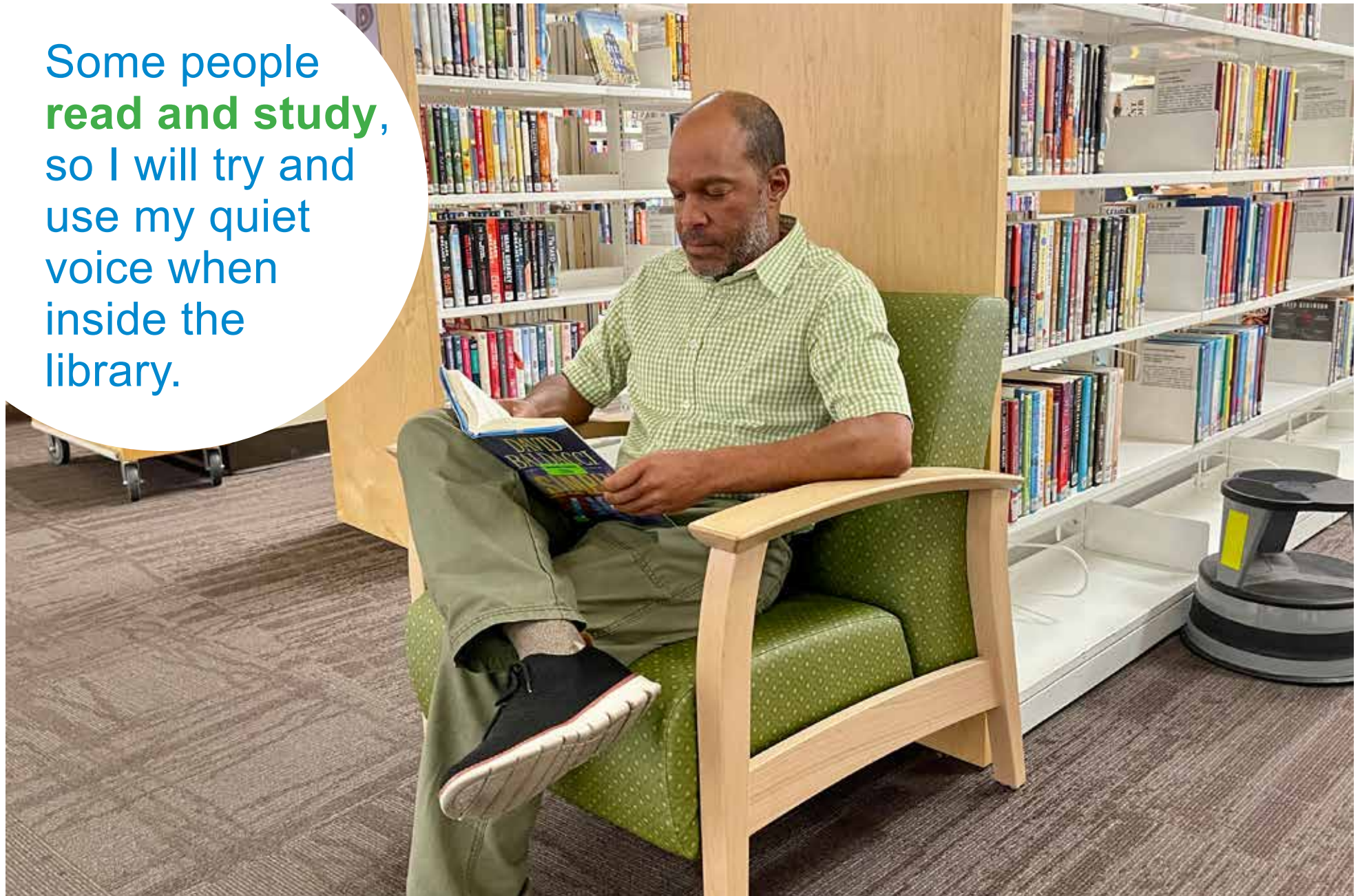
I might hear **security gates** beeping and see them flash red lights. It's ok.

It means **library items need to be checked by staff** before leaving.

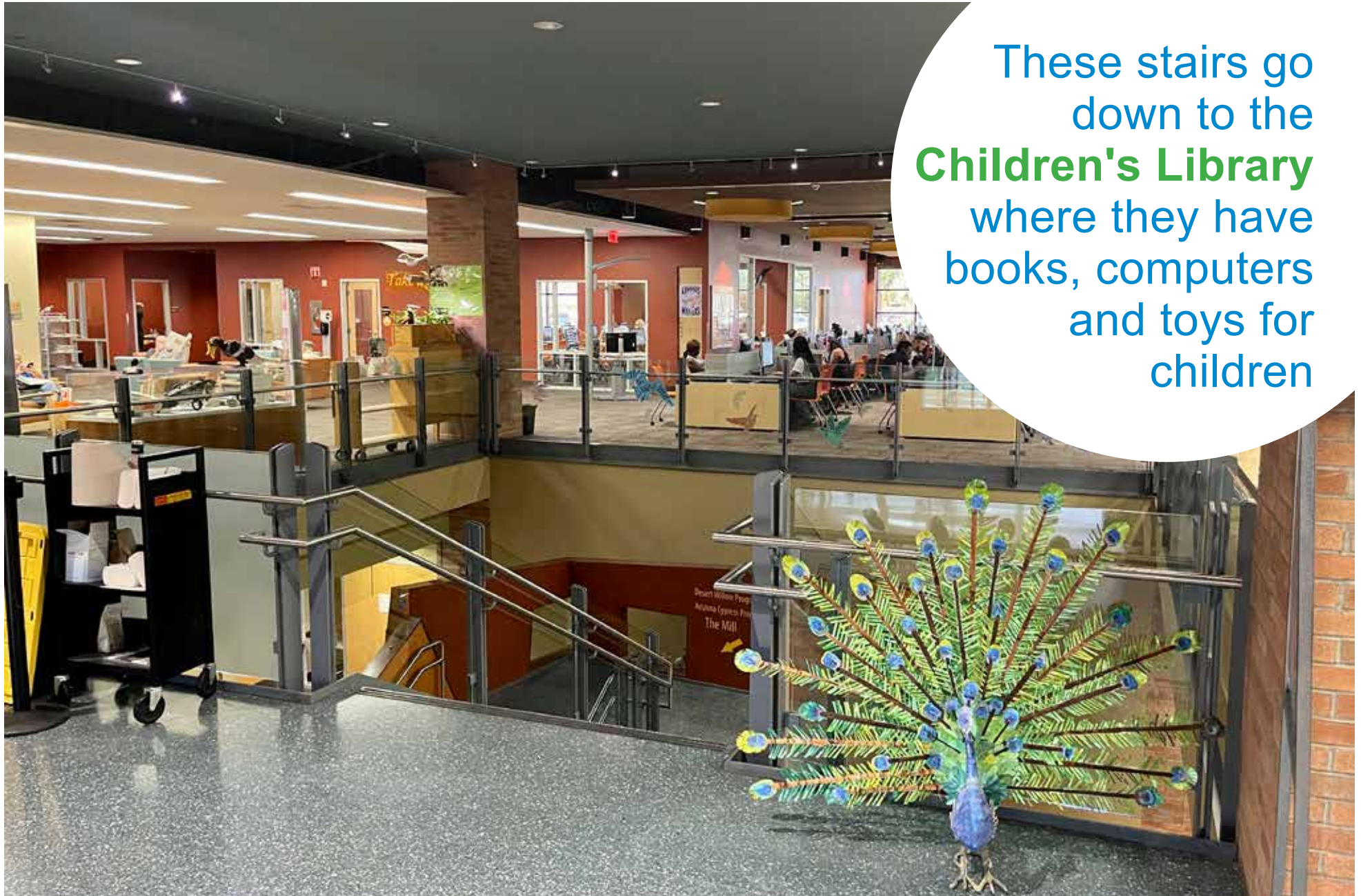
There are lots of places I can **sit to relax and read.**
